**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 982**

**OFFERED BY MR. JOHNSON OF GEORGIA**

Page 2, beginning on line 11, strike “, including the name and exposure history of,”.

Page 2, line 13, insert “, but excludes all personally identifiable information relating to such claimant” before the semicolon.

Page 2, line 22, insert “(excluding all personally identifiable information relating to a claimant who has made, or may make, demands or claims)” before “related”.

At the end of page 2, insert the following (and make such technical and conforming changes as may be appropriate):

1                   “(C) DEFINITIONS.—For purposes of this  
2                   paragraph:

3                   “(i) PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE FI-  
4                   NANCIAL INFORMATION.—The term ‘per-  
5                   sonally identifiable financial information’  
6                   means information that—

7                   “(I) an individual provides to ob-  
8                   tain a financial product or service;

1                   “(II) relates to an individual as a  
2                   result of any transaction involving a  
3                   financial product or service; or

4                   “(III) is obtained about an indi-  
5                   vidual in connection with providing a  
6                   financial product or service.

7                   “(ii)   PERSONALLY   IDENTIFIABLE  
8                   HEALTH INFORMATION.—The term ‘per-  
9                   sonally identifiable health information’  
10                  means information that—

11                  “(I) is created or received by a  
12                  health care provider, health plan, em-  
13                  ployer, or health care clearinghouse;

14                  “(II) relates to the past, present,  
15                  or future physical or mental health or  
16                  condition of an individual, the provi-  
17                  sion of health care to an individual, or  
18                  the past, present, or future payment  
19                  for the provision of health care to an  
20                  individual, and

21                  “(III) either identifies such indi-  
22                  vidual or provides a reasonable basis  
23                  to believe that the use of such infor-  
24                  mation can lead to the identification  
25                  of an individual.

1                   “(iii) PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE IN-  
2                   FORMATION.—The term ‘personally identi-  
3                   fiable information’ means information that  
4                   can be used to identify an individual, in-  
5                   cluding such individual’s name, address,  
6                   telephone number, photograph, social secu-  
7                   rity number, names of children and other  
8                   relatives of the individual, and other identi-  
9                   fying information. It also includes informa-  
10                  tion about such individual’s medical and fi-  
11                  nancial condition, personally identifiable fi-  
12                  nancial information, personally identifiable  
13                  health information, as well as, the amount  
14                  of any payments from the trust made with  
15                  respect to a claim or demand relating to  
16                  such individual.”.
