**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1773**

**OFFERED BY MR. GUTIERREZ OF ILLINOIS**

Page 48, line 6, before "The" insert "(a) IN GENERAL.—".

Page 48, after line 19, insert the following:

1 (b) PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS.—Notwith-  
2 standing any other provision of law, an alien who is eligi-  
3 ble for the immigration benefits described in subsection  
4 (a) is eligible to adjust status to that of an alien lawfully  
5 admitted for permanent residence beginning on the date  
6 of the enactment of this Act. The Secretary shall waive  
7 the grounds of inadmissibility contained in paragraphs  
8 (5), (6), (7), and (9)(B) of section 212(a), and the  
9 grounds of deportability contained in subparagraphs (A)  
10 through (D) of paragraph (1), and paragraph (3), of sec-  
11 tion 237(a), of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8  
12 U.S.C. 1101 et seq.) in the case of such an alien solely  
13 as may be necessary in order to allow the alien to adjust  
14 status under this subsection. Such alien shall not be con-  
15 sidered an unauthorized alien for purposes of section  
16 274A(h)(3) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8  
17 U.S.C. 1324a(h)(3)) or to be unlawfully present as long

1 as the alien has pending an application for such adjust-  
2 ment.
